<a href="#">Registration</a>	You must have the boat registration certificate on board and validation stickers displayed.
<a href="#">Life Jackets</a>	One for each person, properly sized, readily accessible and in good serviceable condition and US Coast Guard approved
<a href="#">Life Jacket to be worn</a>	Less than 12 years of age at all times when underway on a boat less than 65 feet except when in a fully enclosed cabin. If the boat is less than 21 feet all passengers must wear a PFD from Nov 1 to May 1.
<a href="#">Throw able flotation device</a>	Not required for boats less than 16 feet. If the boat is 16 feet or greater a throw able flotation device is required
<a href="#">Sound Producing device</a>	Yes, mouth whistle is acceptable on a motorboat is less than 39 feet in length
<a href="#">Bell</a>	Not required unless your motorboat is greater than 39 feet
<a href="#">Anchor and line</a>	Yes
<a href="#">Backfire Flame arrestor</a>	Inboard and Inboard/Outdrive engines that use gas
<a href="#">Fire Extinguisher</a>	Required, with exceptions. Click on the link to find the number and type of extinguisher required.
<a href="#">Visual Distress signal</a>	Day and night time signals required on motorboats 16 feet or greater after sunset. On vessels less than 16 feet nighttime signals are required between sunset and sunrise.
<a href="#">Navigation Lights</a>	The vessel must carry red and green side lights, masthead and stern. The masthead and stern light can be as one all around white light if your boat is less than 39 feet.
<a href="#">Capacity Plate</a>	If your boat is less than 20 feet the manufacturer should have placed one on your boat. If it is missing it is not violation of the law.
<a href="#">Muffled exhaust</a>	Not required
